Call to Order

Dr. Powell called the meeting to order at 12:47 p.m.

Reminder was made to attend next board meeting in Natchitoches. A schedule of Sunday events will be circulated in advance.

Motion to Adopt the Agenda

Kevin Kelly moved to accept the meeting agenda and the motion was seconded by Melissa Steiner. The motion was **unanimously approved**.

Motion to Adopt the Minutes

Kevin Kelly moved to adopt the meeting minutes from October 23, 2017. The motion was seconded by Melissa Steiner. Corrections to the spelling of Madlyn Bagneris' name and adding Lana Venable as absent were requested. After corrections, the minutes were **unanimously approved**.
